

SIT TEAMS

The school has 4 School Improvement Teams (SIT). The Enjoy and Achieve Team is the umbrella team under which the other 3 teams sit. This is because everything we do at Sunningdale School is about 'Enjoyment' and 'Achievement.' The rationale for the SIT Teams is to provide an holistic approach to school improvement in order to impact on overall school standards and achievement.

The 3 other Teams are as follows:

Positive Contribution

Healthy and Safe

Creative Enterprise

All staff members have a role of responsibility within a team and have dedicated time in which to fulfil their responsibilities. Each Team is led by a Senior Teacher who drives practice from priorities set within the School Development Plan (SDP). Governing Body members also are aligned to Teams within a 'Link' Governor role and regularly attend meetings.

The SIT Teams meet half termly to discuss their progress towards meeting targets within the Team Action Plan and to plan any future action. Within their meetings Teams will also self evaluate their impact and effectiveness on overall school development.

ENJOY AND ACHIEVE:

As the 'umbrella' Team the direction for 'Enjoy and Achieve' comes from the School's two Assistant Head teachers who drive practice through curriculum development and track pupil progress through the on-going analysis of data. The Team also oversees the quality of teaching and learning which encompasses Pupil Learning Plans (PLP's), teacher planning and the promotion of creative practice across school.

POSITIVE CONTRIBUTION:

This Team's remit centres on providing opportunities for parents and pupils to make a 'positive contribution' through partnership working. The Team drives initiatives around ensuring the pupils have an effective 'voice,' the provision of learning opportunities and support mechanisms for parents and extended learning opportunities within the lunchtime/after school period.

HEALTHY/SAFE:

The focus within this Team is on the promotion of health across all areas and ensuring both pupils and staff are kept safe. The Team therefore cover physical activity across school

including both Rebound and Hydro Therapy. The Team also boasts a Health 'Champion' who promotes oversees inclusion in a range of healthy activities across school.

CREATIVE ENTERPRISE:

Enterprise encompasses the promotion of basic skills such as communication, reading, writing and number through involvement in creative practical activities that are motivating and that have an end purpose or result. Pupils have already been involved in making and selling products at our Summer Fayre, Christmas 'Open' evening and Winter Festival.

The Team is currently in the process of ratifying 'best practice' by creating a portfolio for submission towards the achievement of the Research Charter Mark.
